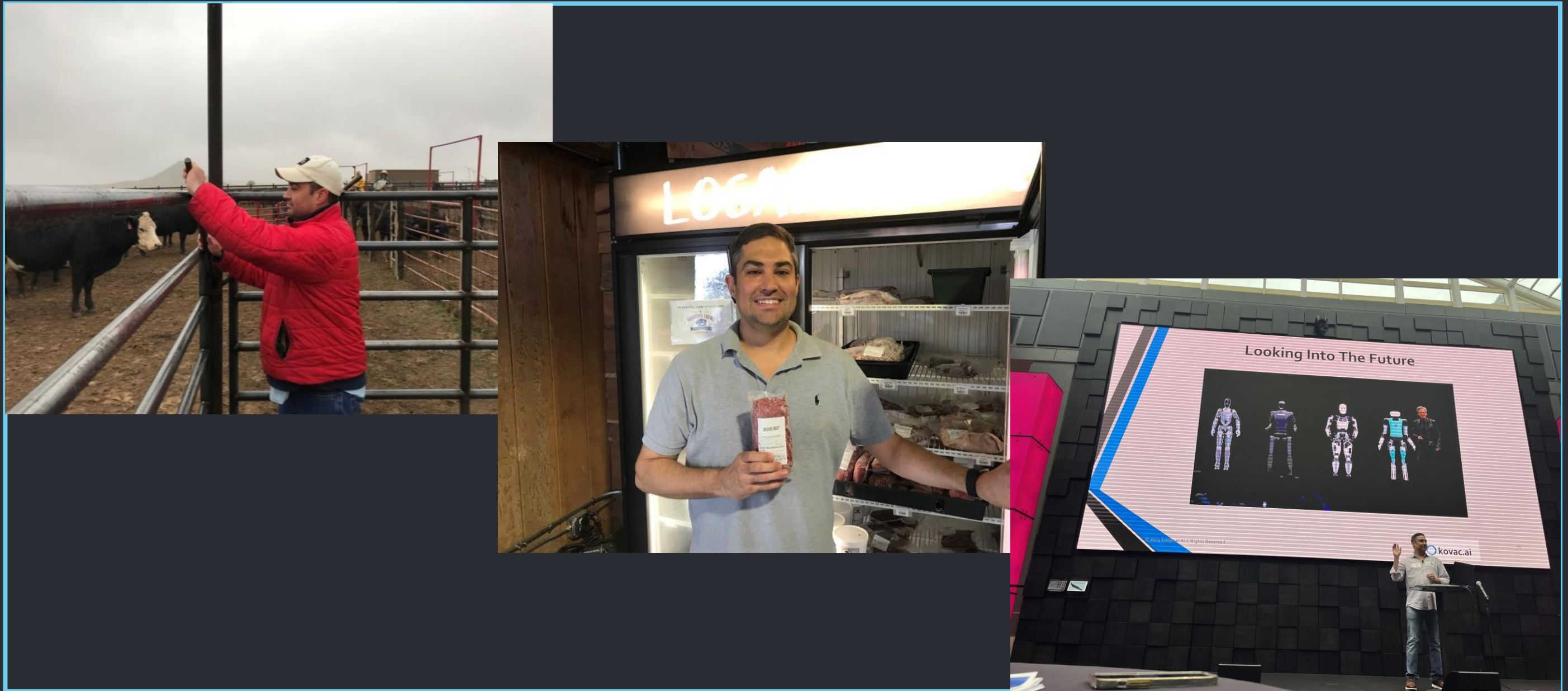

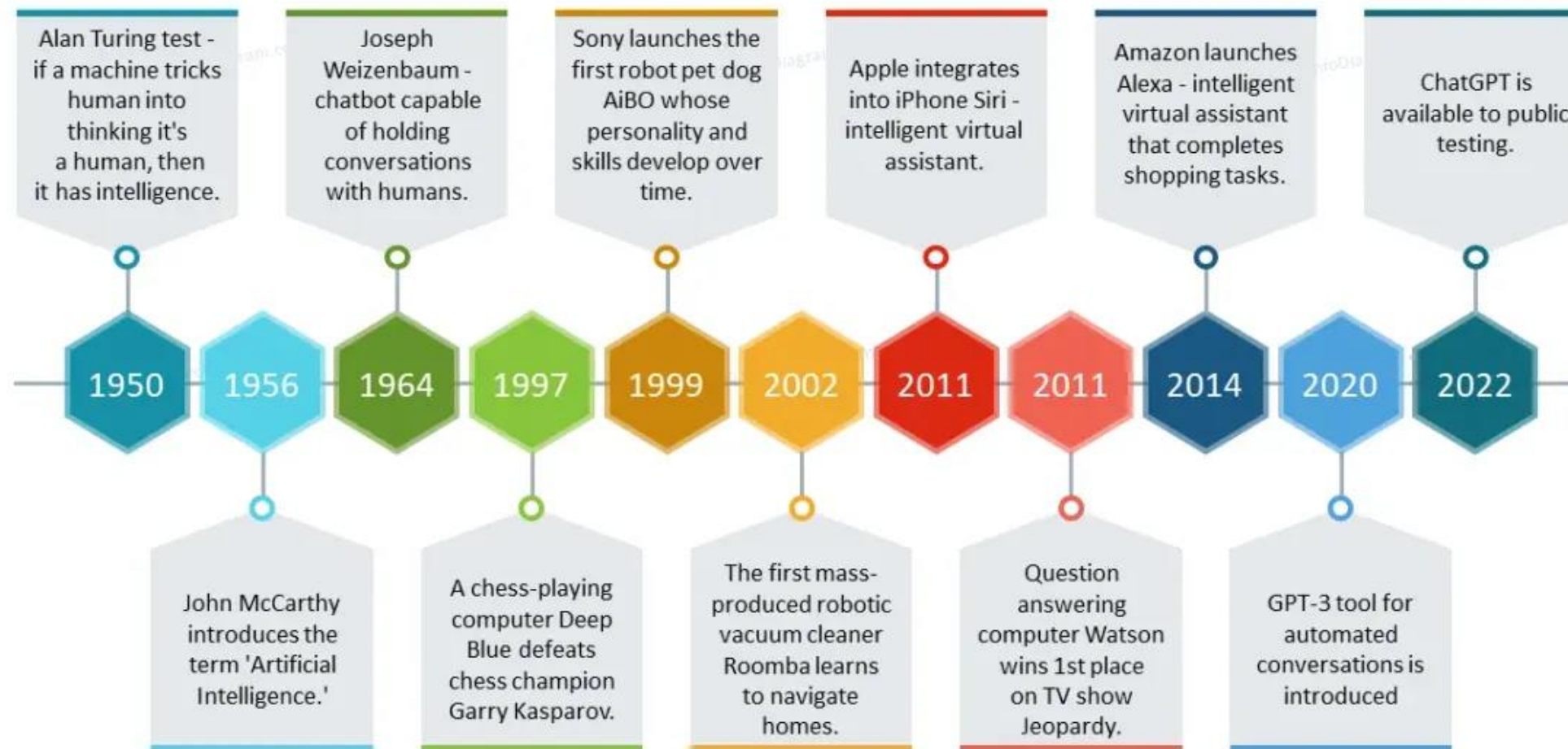

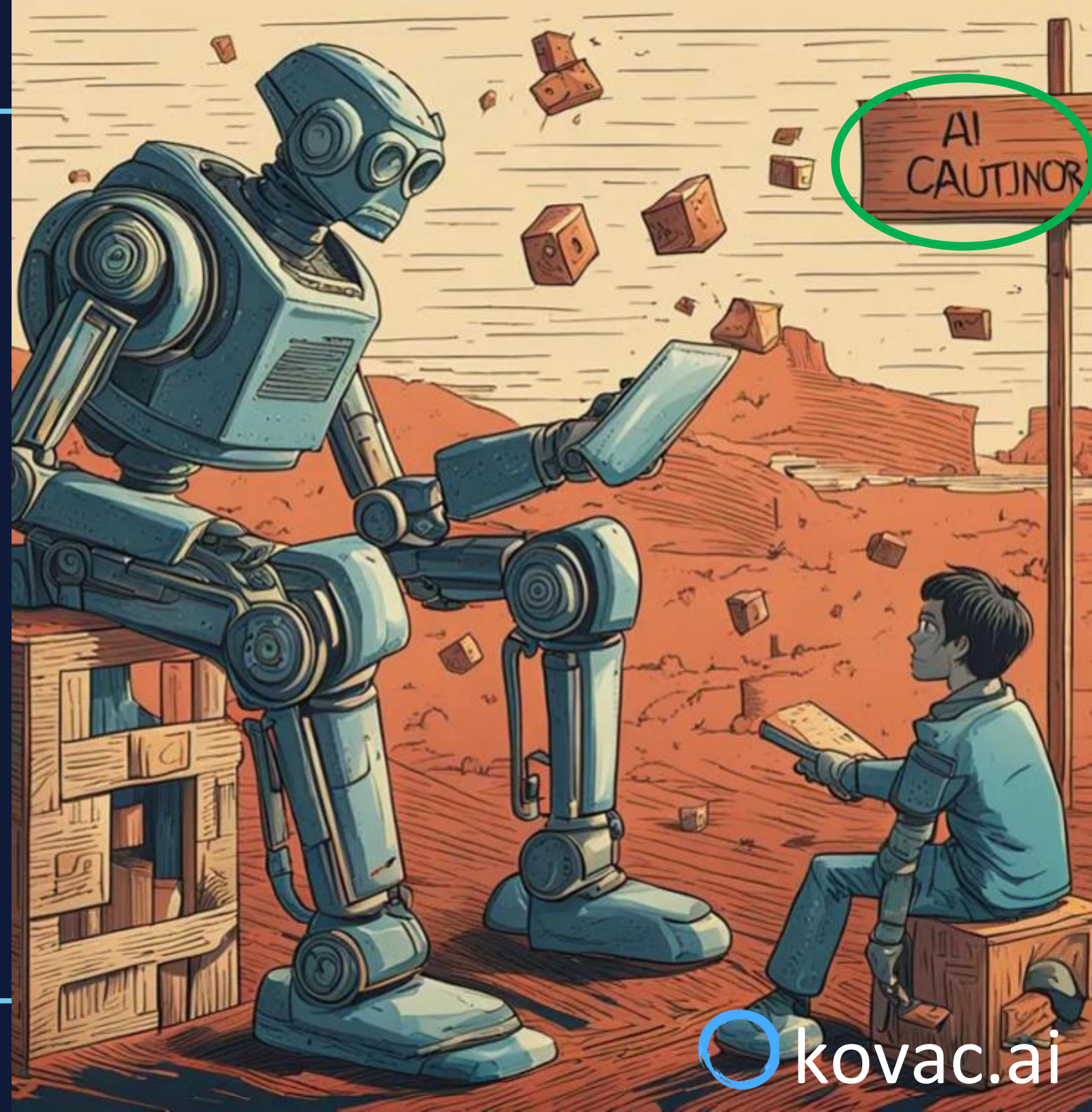

Key Terminology

- **Artificial Intelligence: Capability of machines to interpret data, learn from it, and make decisions autonomously**
- **Large Language Models (LLMs): Advanced AI algorithms that can understand, generate, and predict text by analyzing vast amounts of language data**
- **AI Prompt: Instructions that guide an AI model to generate specific responses or content, ranging from answering questions to creating text, images, or code**

Lawyer: ChatGPT said the cases were real

Schwartz provided an excerpt from ChatGPT queries in which he asked the AI tool whether *Varghese* is a real case. ChatGPT answered that it "is a real case" and "can be found on legal research databases such as Westlaw and LexisNexis." When asked if the other cases provided by ChatGPT are fake, it answered, "No, the other cases I provided are real and can be found in reputable legal databases such as LexisNexis and Westlaw."

ChatGPT Limitations

Limitation	Description
Lack of Common Sense	ChatGPT may produce illogical responses as it lacks real-world experience and common sense reasoning.
Biased Responses	The AI may exhibit biases due to non-representative training data, influencing its responses.
Limited Knowledge of Niche Topics	Struggles with niche topics due to less available data or specific expertise in those areas.
Usage Limits	Free version users face restrictions on interaction frequency and conversation length.
Plus User Usage Limits	ChatGPT Plus users have a message cap of 40 messages per 3 hours, with adjustments based on demand.
Accuracy	Responses can sometimes be inaccurate or outdated, requiring user verification for reliability.
Incomplete Responses	May provide partial answers in complex scenarios due to computational constraints.
Ethical and Moral Reasoning	Lacks the ability to perform nuanced judgments required in sensitive or ethical dilemmas.
Input and Output Limitations	Supports only textual inputs and outputs, limiting functionality with non-text data.
Language Limitations	Varies in proficiency across different languages, with some having less robust responses than others.
Hallucinations	ChatGPT may generate plausible but factually incorrect or nonsensical responses, known as hallucinations.

What Is Generative AI?

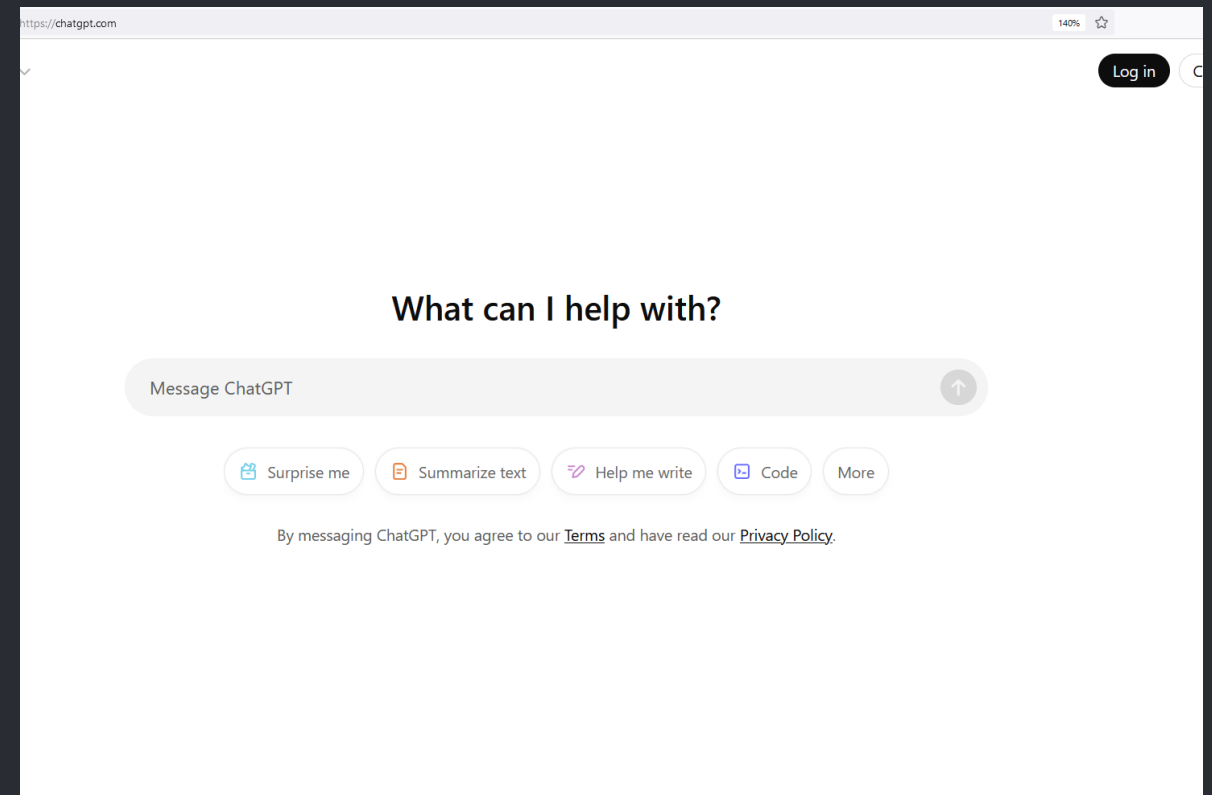
- AI tools that generate outputs based on your 'conversation'
 - **Text to Text** (ideas, blog, email, research)
 - **Text to Image** (create new images and animations)
 - **Text to Document** (Excel, PowerPoint, PDF)
 - **Text to Code** (Python, Java, C++ and more)
 - **Text to Video** & more
- Great for research, ideation, revisions, creating content, rewriting and more
- Popular tools: **ChatGPT**, Copilot, **Perplexity**, **Claude**, Gemini
- Use natural language (not like search engines)

How Can I Use ChatGPT?


- Free and paid versions
 - Paid version recommended for business
- Different versions: GPT 4, 4.o, o1-preview, etc.
- Start with asking how it can help you.
 - “I am new to AI, how can you help me?”



Introduction to ChatGPT

How Do I Set Up an Account?

- Start with creating your account
 - Or, link it to existing profile like Google
- You will receive a confirmation email; click to confirm
- Once confirmed, you will have access to your account and history
- Upgrade to paid version for \$20-25/mo
 - More features & better outputs
- Access via desktop and mobile

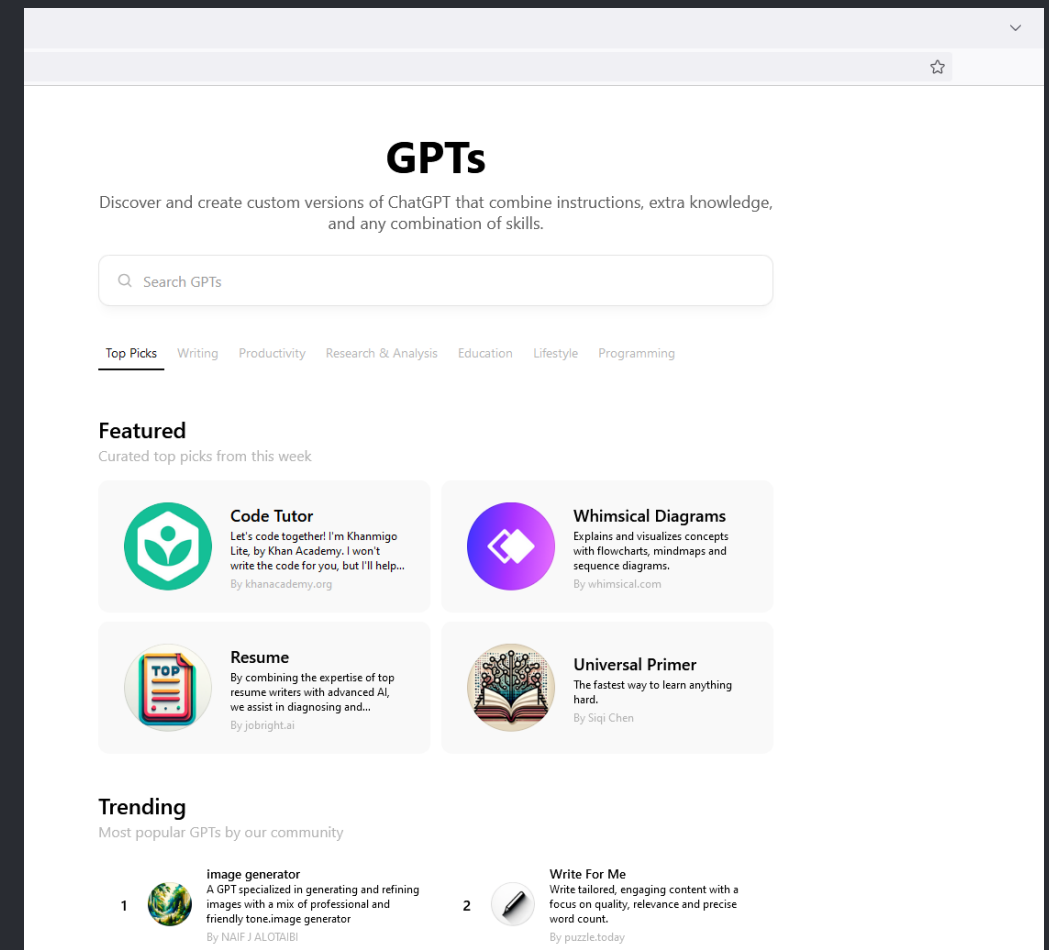

How Is Claude.ai Different?

- **More advanced reasoning and analytics skills**
 - **Complex analysis and reports**
 - **Technical writing**
 - **Data analysis**
 - **Long term analysis**
- **Projects**
 - **Self contained, ongoing chat**
 - **Upload documents, etc.**



ChatGPT vs. Claude.ai



Strengths

- Excellent at general knowledge tasks and explanations
- Strong coding assistance and debugging capabilities
- Good at creative writing and brainstorming
- Offers multimodal capabilities (image input/analysis)

Weaknesses

- Can sometimes be overly verbose
- Response quality can be inconsistent
- May occasionally provide outdated information
- Free version has more limited capabilities



Strengths

- Advanced reasoning and analytical capabilities
- Strong at complex problem-solving
- More nuanced understanding of context
- Highly capable at technical and academic writing
- Maintains context in longer conversations

Weaknesses

- No real-time internet access
- Can't generate images
- Overly careful with certain topics
- Learning curve for optimal prompting

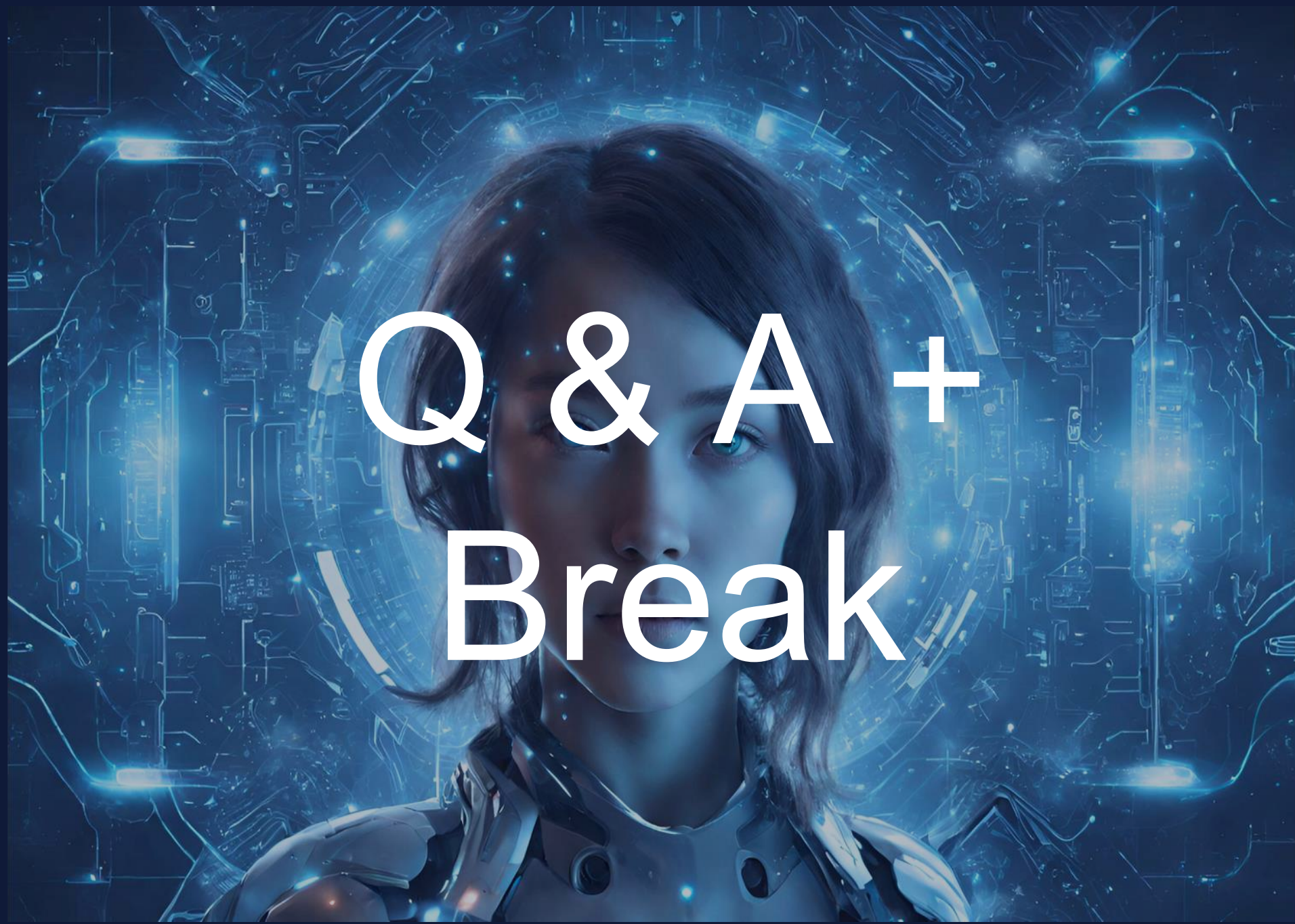
